Compliance Summary

- One inspection occurred during the last six months.
- One service request (complaint) was logged with Council since the last CLG meeting. S/R2415071, 08/05/24. Complainant wanting to discuss the entrance gates to walkway around Winstone quarry and river walkway, no access for wheelchairs. Complaint dealt with by Parks and Recreation (Cat Wilde) as not condition of consent.
- Acoustic bunds around walkway remain in good shape with good grass cover and no slumping.
- Plants along the banks of stage one has good growth, the southern batter of stage 2 has been planted, Natural Habitat continue planting in the next season as and when areas are battered and complete.
- Gravel extraction continues within stage 2 no set date for completion of this stage as dependent on incoming orders for more material for road works.

Excel spreadsheet of the listed conditions of consent has been done and forwarded onto Chairman to distribute. I am still scrolling through Council filing system at present to locate some reports and information. These will then be added to the spreadsheet and once complete I will send through via email.
